San Juan 2017

The 15th Annual OPTU San Juan fishing trip will be Friday March 10th to Thursday March 16, 2017. The trip is full. We'll be staying at the Octagon Inn - if any OPTUers are up the same week drop by and say hello or wave to us on the river.

Cluff Ranch

OPTU is sponsoring a fly fishing trip and conservation day at Cluff Ranch. The bunkhouses and camping will be available to us from Friday 24 March to Sunday 26 March. If women attend, we will hold one of the two bunkhouses aside for their exclusive use. Breakfast and dinner will be provided by OPTU on the 25th, Breakfast will be provided by OPTU on the 26th, and lunch makings will be available so people can make their own on the 25th and 26th.
